

NHS LANARKSHIRE AUDIOLOGY SERVICES HEARING AID SELF CARE SESSIONS

NHS Lanarkshire currently offers a range of open access and appointed repair clinics for hearing aid maintenance.

A new clinic has been implemented allowing hearing aid users and/or a family member to maintain their own hearing aid if they prefer to do so. This clinic is currently running within Audiology departments throughout Lanarkshire.

This can reduce hospital visits for those travelling a distance to attend a clinic, whilst also giving service users the ability to maintain and service their own hearing aids without waiting on an appointment.

The session consists of:

- A powerpoint instruction on hearing aid re-tubing and basic hearing aid maintenance.
- Practical session.
- Service Pack & Certificate issued.
