

## Passport to Leisure

The Passport to Leisure scheme gives price reductions on sport, leisure and cultural activities in North and South Lanarkshire. Your personal photo-card is valid for a full year from the date of purchase.

What are the benefits of a Passport to Leisure membership?

Members get up to 50% off the normal adult charge for a wide range of leisure activities, including:

**Pools / Sports Centres / Access NL** - Swim, health suite, aerotone, conditioning room, carpet bowling, athletics tracks (individual), creche, equipment hire, bowling green membership, casual game of bowls, bowls hire, gym, fitness classes, massage and infrared sauna.

**Aquatec, Motherwell** - Swim, health suite, massage, infra-red sauna and conditioning room.

**The Time Capsule, Coatbridge** - Swimzone and conditioning gym. Your Passport to Leisure card can be used at the Time Capsule at off peak times only, which are 10am to 4pm, Monday to Friday, and generally correspond to the school term, excluding the

month of June. These times are displayed at The Time Capsule's reception.

**Water Sports** - Locker key deposit, sailing, windsurfing, canoeing, rowing, fun-boats, fishing and orienteering maps.

**Libraries** - Reservations (charges apply to non stock items only) and CD loans.

**Parks** - Allotments, putting and pitch and putt.

**Golf** - Season Ticket (available to buy from the golf course), round of golf, day ticket and golf driving range.

**Theatres** - Tickets for shows.

**Community Arts** - Classes and courses.

A number of other prices will be advertised separately e.g. special promotions and group discounts.

## **How to join**

You can join the Passport to Leisure scheme if you live in North or South Lanarkshire, are over 16 years of age and fit into one of these eligible groups:

- Unemployed Person.

- Income Support.
- Person Over 60.
- Working Tax Credit.
- Widow.
- Person in receipt of other state pension e.g. war pension.
- Housing Benefits (Council Tax Benefit).
- Students (Full-Time Only).
- Skillseekers.
- Disabled Person.
- Incapacity Benefit.
- Princes Trust / Invalid Care.

Items which are accepted as proof for each of these are listed on the Passport to Leisure form.
